- Continually review and maintain a Management System that complies with AS4801;
- Implement and monitor these safety systems and procedures on all projects;
- Assign individual accountabilities for health and safety performance;
- Investigate all incidents and initiate effective control measures to prevent the same or similar incidents from recurring;
- Commit to establishing measurable objectives and targets that are aimed at the elimination of work-related incidents, injury and illness;
- Promote a positive culture where workers take responsibility not only for their own safety but for the safety of others around them:
- Respect the rights of all workers to express their concern over safety issues in the work place and to expect those concerns to be addressed;
